6th Sunday of Ordinary Time—Year B 11 February 2024

Sixth Sunday of Ordinary time we see Jesus cures a leper. Leprosy was a feared disease during the time of Jesus and lepers were regarded as 'living dead'. They were considered to be truly cursed by God. If they had a reason to go to the town they would have had to carry a bell with them. They would constantly ring this bell as they walked and cried out "Unclean, Unclean", informing people to keep away from them because they were struck with a very contagious disease. Now Jesus heals the leper, manifesting once again his power over this form of evil, as well as his compassion for these unfortunate people. To cure leprosy was like raising the dead. The cured person could now be restored to the community of the living.

The striking sentence in today's gospel is, "A man with leprosy came to him and begged him on his knees, "If you are willing, you can make me clean." Jesus was indignant. He reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" The leper is searching for God's will to get cured. He got cured. Dear friends, how often do you search for God's will amid problems? Have you ever experienced the words of God-I am willing. When the law, society, religion, and even his family kept him away, Jesus touched him and took him back to life. Even when everyone stands against you, are you able to experience the touch of God? For the Lord he was not someone unclean but a child of God in desperate need. For the Lord you are not someone unwanted but a child of God

It is my pleasure to introduce myself. I was born and raised in the south of India, in Karnataka state. I am from a family of nine including my parents. I have six siblings with three brothers and three sisters. My mother was called into eternal bliss in 2019 and my father in 2020.

After completing my Grade 10 education, I joined the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (otherwise known as CMI) in 1988. During the seminary formation of nearly fifteen years, I completed my religious and secular studies as well and was ordained a religious priest on 28 December 2002.

The first appointment after Ordination was as parish priest,

in one of the parishes under the Diocese of Belthangady, in Karnataka state for a year, from March 2003 to April 2004. During the years 2004 and 2005, I completed a Bachelor of Education [B Ed]. From the years 2005 to 2011, I served as a Principal in one of the colleges of CMI St. Paul's Province Mysuru, which had nearly 2300 students and 130 teaching and support staff.

I was also part of our retreat team from 2011 to 2012. Following this ministry, I was appointed Associate Director and Principal of Chavara Cultural Centre. This is one of our cultural centres based in Kochi, in the state of Kerala state. This appointment was for two years from 2012 to 2014.

From 2014 to 2016, I had the opportunity to complete my Masters in Kannada Literature. Besides studying I also concurrently served as associate parish priest in St. Mary's Church, Bangalore.

From 2017 to 2021 I was appointed as the Principal of one of our colleges in Mysuru, namely Bharath Matha Composite PU College, Koppa.

I arrived in Brisbane, Australia on 21 August 2022. I was working as associate pastor at St Mary's Parish, Ipswich and Jubilee Parish, from October 2022 to December 2023. St Rita is my first parish in Australia as a Parish Priest. I ask your support and prayers to be a Good Shepherd.








PROJECT COMPASSION

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY, MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS:

Recent Activities - replaced BBQ hose, regulator and gas bottle to new Standards (WH&S), removed rotted out garden seat near Parish Office (WH&S), installed additional garden seat in Columbarium garden, repaired broken water supply pipe near presbytery and installed an isolation valve.
