GOSPEL REFLECTION

Come Back to the Well

A while back, a young youth minister came to our parish to help out on weekends. He loved coffee, the stronger the better. And if he wasn't drinking coffee, he had a large bottle of Diet Coke in his hands. So I was surprised on the night before Ash Wednesday when he announced he had decided to give up caffeine for Lent.

The next day after four services and blessings of people with ashes, I settled in my room to relax. The young guy buzzed me on the intercom and asked if I would come to his room. He was sick. He told me that he had the worst headache in his life. With no caffeine in his system, he had gone into serious withdrawal. I gave him some painkillers, and they almost immediately made a difference. I didn't tell him that the brand I used had caffeine as one of the ingredients. I figured he needed to be weaned from it rather than go cold turkey.

Why do we thirst and long for living water like the chosen people thirsted for water in the desert? It is because it has been taken from us, not by anyone else, but because of our own sinfulness. We have been blessed to have been drinking the same water that Jesus offered to the Samaritan woman in the gospel. But we have inexplicably, through our own sinfulness, chosen to go without it, cold turkey, and we realise now that we cannot live without it. So we need to admit our sinfulness and come back to the well of life, to be once again refreshed and renewed. It is a well that will never run dry.


