## **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

I allow a sense of internal stillness to emerge by deliberatively slowing down and letting go of my stream of thoughts and feelings. I ask the Holy Spirit to come to my aid, to create a space for my encounter with the Lord. When I am ready, I read the Gospel several times over. I note and attend to what draws me from within the passage. Like John, I, too, may look at Jesus ... really look, and see him for who he truly is. How would I describe him: a deeply trusted teacher, a friend or...? Maybe I do not know him well enough or even trust him yet? Or – again like John – I may want to ponder my sense of growing faith and the ways in which I recognise Christ in my life today. I reflect on who he is for me, in all aspects of my life. I beg the Lord that I might see him, love him, and follow him more fully, day by day. I spend time in prayerful attention, perhaps pondering my own baptism. What might God be asking of me now, as his witness? I speak to the Lord from the depths of my heart and mind. As we begin 2020, I pray for the Spirit to rest on the whole world, on the baptised and un-baptised; to bring healing, hope and a recognition of Christ in our midst.



John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus as found in John's Gospel. John's Gospel differs from the other Gospels because John does not describe Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist. Instead, John the Baptist announces that he knows that Jesus is the Son of God. In today's reading, John the Baptist sees Jesus approaching and cries out, giving witness about who Jesus is. In John's testimony he says that he saw the Spirit descend upon Jesus. By this sign, John the Baptist knew that Jesus was the one who is to come after him.

John the Baptist uses two titles for Jesus that are familiar to us. John calls Jesus the "Lamb of God" and the "Son of God." By using these titles, John the Baptist identifies Jesus' ultimate purpose: to redeem sinful humanity.

John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus clearly distinguishes John's baptism from the Baptism that Jesus will inaugurate. John baptizes with water; Jesus will baptize with the Holy Spirit. John also puts his practice of baptism in the context of Jesus' ministry. The purpose of John's baptism was to make Jesus known to Israel.

John the Baptist's sense of purpose is clearly identified in this reading: he baptized in order to prepare for and make known the ministry of the One who was to follow. John's witness is an excellent example of what it means to be a disciple. By our Baptism, we are called to make Jesus known to all the world by our words and by the witness of our lives.

### **Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:**

**RECENT ACTIVITIES:** – deep cleaning of carpets in presbytery.

**CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE**: – painting of presbytery gutters, removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), high-pressure water-blast pathway leading to church, polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), renewal of Termite Management system around the church building, fix/replace damaged fence railing at OSHC, investigate leaking ladies toilet in church, investigate malfunctioning light at entrance to ladies toilet, deep cleaning of carpets in presbytery.

**POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING:** – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace/repair rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.


### Primary School Christian Religious Instruction (CRI)
