

Dear Parishioners,

As you know, Archbishop appointed me as the Administrator of this Parish Community. My name is Fr Rony Kalapurackal Chacko. I am from one of the Southern states of India, called Kerala, the same region from Fr Joseph, former parish priest. At home I have my parents (Chacko and Rosamma) and 8 siblings. I am the 6 one among the 9. I belong to a religious order, called MCBS (Missionary Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament) which founded in Kerala in 1933. I am ordained as a priest in 2015. First four years of priesthood, I worked in one of our communications offices. In 2020 January, just

before Covid, landed in Brisbane. First couple of years, I was appointed as the Associate Pastor at Jubilee Parish and from 2022 January as Parish priest at Star of the Sea Cleveland. RECENT ACTIVITIES - annual termite inspection and pest control spraying for Parish Office, Presbytery, Church and OSHC building (9 Oct), WH&S Audit by Archdiocesan Workplace Health & Safety Advisor (10 Oct), repaired hinge on Holy Oils cabinet. Replaced Fire Blanket sign in kitchen of Presbytery.

CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE - repairs to corroded church/school gutters (repairs scheduled ??), leak in cistern connection in church toilet, polishing vinyl flooring in church, clean second half of OSHC verandah wall & paint, clean & paint inside walls of OSHC building, removal of mould and sanding/ painting of presbytery window sills doors and door frames (scheduled for 2024), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark (on hold), painting of presbytery gutters and eaves (on hold), progressive upgrade of pole lights in school/church carpark.

POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING - replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), plaster repairs to ceilings in presbytery.
