GOSPEL REFLECTION

" Sheep are Followers "

"We are his people, the sheep of his flock". How picturesque - all those cute critters grazing obediently, and I know I'm supposed to want that, but in my heart I'm thinking, "No thanks". Sheep are followers. I'm a terrible sheep. I don't want to follow. I want to control. For example, I want to control my schedule so that I never have to wake up while it's still dark. I want to turn on the radio as I'm getting ready and never hear a pledge drive. I want all the traffic lights in town to turn green as I drive up to

But the problem is deeper, and my own life reveals that, especially as I ponder the big things I'd like to control. I want my family to give me my way in everything. I don't want my friends to get sick, or at least to get well when I pray for them, especially the one I keep praying for who keeps getting sicker. I don't want to worry about finances, kids, the environment. I want everyone to practice compassion instead of escalating conflict to violence.

Uh-oh. The real issue here, I see, isn't that sheep are followers. The real issue is that sheep are not in control. Giving up control isn't a goal we can work toward - it's a statement about reality. We can't give up control because we don't have it in the first place! Yes, we must pray and work - clothing the naked, feeding the hungry, visiting the sick and imprisoned. But we must also acknowledge that we don't control the outcome, and we can practice gratitude to the one who made us, whose kindness endures forever, who has placed us in this amazing flock and invited us to serve with joyful song.

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

<u>RECENT ACTIVITIES</u> – continued painting Presbytery internal walls including plaster repairs, 6-monthly fire system and equipment checks in parish office, presbytery and OSHC.

CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE – removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery - to be scheduled in June, renewal of Termite Management system around the church/school building – to be scheduled 6 July, repairs to corroded church/school gutters (quote still pending), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark (on hold), painting of presbytery gutters and eaves (on hold), polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), replace rotted timber on archway leading into church verandah, clean second half of OSHC verandah wall and paint.

POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence

along side school oval).



Each year parishes in the Archdiocese of Brisbane take up the Peter's Pence collection as a retiring collection. The collection is to be taken at the Masses the weekend around the Feast of Sts Peter and Paul. Therefore, this year's collection will be taken up on the 25 June 2023 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time).

The Peter's Pence Collection gives Catholics in Australia an opportunity to join in communion with the Catholic faithful throughout the world in support of the charitable works of the Holy See.

Some talking points on this collection include:

- The Peter's Pence Collection is an annual collection of the Catholic Church around the world.
- The collection allows the Holy Father to respond to the most needy throughout the world, to offer timely, effective emergency assistance to our suffering brothers and sisters.
- In the Archdiocese of Brisbane, we take this collection up as a retiring collection.

Peter's Pence Collection

Every year this collection is taken up around the Feast of Sts Peter and Paul. How extraordinary that we celebrate the memory of Peter and Paul on one day. Surely each of these great apostles deserves their own day. Why do we celebrate them on the one day and why are they so often represented together in paintings and icons? In Rome you almost never see Peter without seeing Paul and vice versa. And why is their memory celebrated so intensely in one city when they were so different, the odd couple, Peter and Paul, Simon and Saul? Beyond all their differences and beyond their fights and disagreements, the parting of the ways, the two men found their way to each when they found their way to martyrdom. It was their death in Rome that sealed the bond that means we celebrate their memory on one day and we paint their picture in one icon and we celebrate their memory most intensely in one city, the city where they died and where they lie buried now. It was in coming so close to Christ in death that they found their way to each other, beyond all the differences and disagreements. It was in that moment of witness that we call martyrdom that they became locked together on one day, in one place, one celebration.
