GOSPEL REFLECTION

Perfection 101

(Matthew 5: 38 - 48)

Full disclosure: I have never done this, offered myself to an enemy for a second round. The very idea of turning the other cheek is totally appalling. When Jesus says offer no resistance to one who is evil, I say: Lord, you've got to be kidding. Of course, I'm going to resist evil. I'm going to run from the near occasion of the bad guys the moment I see them on the horizon. Jesus wants me to surrender my coat along with my shirt, and work twice as long for someone who's already taking advantage of me. The capstone of the whole teaching is the most ludicrous: love your enemy. Is Jesus pulling our leg?

It's obvious from reading the gospels that Jesus has a sense of humour. But he doesn't simply clown around. Jesus says all of these preposterous things to bring us along to the bottom line on this way of thinking: Be perfect, as God is perfect. Because God does turn the other cheek, doesn't resist us even when we're evil, gives and gives, and loves us deeply. Maybe we won't do these things. But thank heaven God will.



A Notice from Fr Ladu

I wish to provide you with some updated guidance on liturgical practices especially with Lent and Easter approaching and given that at present there are low rates of community transmission of COVID.

During the season of Lent and for Easter ceremonies:

- On Ash Wednesday, parishes may resume making the sign of the cross on the forehead and are no longer restricted to sprinkling ashes over the head.
- Parishioners may touch the cross if they wish during Veneration of the Cross on Good Friday but it is recommended that they still refrain from kissing the cross.

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

RECENT ACTIVITIES – continued installation of side view panels either side of chapel doors.

<u>CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE</u> – install new Parish letterbox in new location, repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark, repair to plaster wall in Chapel (caused by statue bracket), painting of presbytery gutters and eaves, removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), renewal of Termite Management system around the church building (quote obtained).

<u>POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING</u> – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace/repair rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.
