GOSPEL REFLECTION

Regaining Balance

Flat on my back for three weeks, fighting an infection that ravaged my body and attacked both legs, leading to surgery and talk of possible amputation of one or both, I awoke intact but with a gruelling regimen of physical therapy three times a day. Exhausted physically, mentally, and spiritually I went through the paces, mumbling like a zombie.

One morning I found myself with the challenge of standing on one foot while placing the other gently on top of an orange safety cone. The goal was to not knock the cone over or crush it while retaining my balance. I couldn't do it no matter what encouragement the young and pretty therapist gave me. Frustrated, I finally kicked the cone across the room shouting, "You don't get it. I couldn't do this back when I had two healthy legs". Embarrassed at my outburst, I just stood there quietly on one leg. "Congratulations!" she smiled. "Look at you. This is the balance I was looking for ... and the attitude".

That was the genesis of my recovery. Six months later when I baptised her first baby, I stood on one foot and thanked her for helping me find the balance I needed.

RITE OF ELECTION

The Rite of Election is a step in the RCIA journey (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). This step is called election because the acceptance made by the Church is founded on the election by God, in whose name the Church acts. The step is also called the enrolment of names because as a pledge of fidelity the candidates inscribe their names in the book [Book of the Elect] that lists those who have been chosen for initiation.

RCIA 106.

'The Elect' (which stems from the word, 'election') is the name given to catechumens chosen by God and affirmed by the Church as ready to celebrate Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the next Easter Vigil.

Our Parish has two catechumens, Brooke and Luke, being presented at the Rite of Election in the Cathedral of St Stephen this Sunday 26th February. Please keep them in your prayers as they journey to the Easter Sacraments.

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

RECENT ACTIVITIES - repaired plaster wall in Chapel (caused by statue bracket), continued installation of side view panels either side of chapel doors, installed new Parish letterbox in new location and removed old letterbox. <u>CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE</u> – repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark, painting of presbytery gutters and eaves, removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), renewal of Termite Management system around the church building (quote obtained). POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace/repair rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.


