GOSPEL REFLECTION

"THE NIGHT IS EAR SPENT "

We know for sure that Santa Claus is coming to town; and so is Snoopy, Peanuts, Frosty, the Grinch, Rudolph, and more seasonal visitors than we may care to name. We also know that Jesus is coming, but he doesn't advertise his arrival as relentlessly as these others so we aren't sure quiet when. Will he arrive in time for the holidays? Too late to stop the next war? Too soon for me to acquire all the things I'd like to have in this world? This is the Advent from which the season takes its name. Jesus is coming, and his advent is the one all these modern myths seek to recreate. Will Charlie Brown find the real meaning of Christmas? Only with a Scripture-quoting friend like Linus. With the Grinch get a life? Only if he opens his eyes to the world he's always had. Jesus is coming all the time, but we won't know it if we refuse to change. That is the purpose of Advent, to give us fair notice that it's time to take time seriously. For whom or what are you waiting? Be a friend like Linus to someone who has not heard the message of the story of Bethlehem. Share your faith with someone who is still waiting for love to come. The first weekend of Advent means the blessing of the Wreath and Candles. The circle of the wreath, without and beginning or an end, symbolises God's unending love for us and reminds us of eternity. The evergreen leaves represented growth and hopes of eternal life. The symbol of evergreens is rather lost in our part of the world, so Australian gum leaves, nuts and flowers are sometimes substituted.



Our first Advent Candle is the Prophet Candle or the Candle of Hope because it reminds us of the prophets – those who spoke God's word to the people during the hundreds of years before Jesus was born. The prophets gave the people hope by telling them about God.





In Western Christianity, the First Sunday of Advent is the start of the Christian year and begins a season of four Sunday's, culminating in the celebration of Christmas.

The First Sunday of Advent is marked in some churches by lighting of the first of five candles, held together by a wreath of greenery. The final candle is lit on Christmas Day representing Christ as the light of the world.

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

RECENT ACTIVITIES: commenced construction of OSHC building extension (approx. 4 month project).

CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE: — clean and paint presbytery walls on shady side of building, obtain quotes for removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), high-pressure water-blast pathway leading to church, polishing vinyl flooring in church, investigate evidence of water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), obtain quote for Termite management system renewal around the church building, fix/replace damaged fence railing at OSHC.

POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING: replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.


Sacrament of Reconciliation
