## **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

"The Miracle of Language"

God created the world with a word, Scripture tells us. God spoke the word BE, and all that is came into being. In the same way, God spoke divinity into human form when Jesus the Word "became flesh and dwelt among us". Finally, the Spirit of Holiness becomes available to us when Jesus breathes the simple words, "Receive the Holy Spirit".

The gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit are defined by lists of words that school children memorise, but behind those words are powerful realities. Invoking the Spirit of joy, peace, patience, and love will create quite a different world than the one invoked by anger, bitterness, and indifference. Lives are bound together or drawn apart by words spoken or withheld. Stewardship over the power of words is a holy reality.

Brothers and sisters.


Archbishop Mark writes:

We have begun the long and complex process of moving towards a synodal mode of governance in the Church, but the process is far from complete; and there is much to be done to embed synodal governance more securely at every level in the Archdiocese... Synodality implies inclusion, and therefore we will have to keep asking how we might at every level include women in the decision -making processes of the Archdiocese. So too synodality requires transparency and accountability, and we will have to keep asking what we need to do make the Archdiocese more transparent and accountable.

#### **Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:**

<u>RECENT ACTIVITIES</u> – continued painting Presbytery internal walls, inspected toilets in church (connection rubbers perished) and presbytery (roots in toilet bowl) - work scheduled for next week.

<u>CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE</u> – repairs to corroded church/school gutters (quote still pending), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark, painting of presbytery gutters and eaves (on hold), removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), renewal of Termite Management system around the church/school building (quote obtained), replace rotted timber on archway leading into church verandah, clean second half of OSHC verandah wall.

<u>POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING</u> – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval).
