Peter must have felt duped by God when Jesus rebuked him. What did he say that was so bad? When Jesus foretold of his future suffering and death, Peter took what he considered an appropriate defensive stand. Not you, Lord! Never!

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

<u>RECENT ACTIVITIES</u> – replaced rotted timber and repainted archway leading into church verandah, replaced three windows smashed by vandals in the OSHC building.

<u>CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE</u> – annual servicing of air conditioners in OSHC, church, presbytery and parish office (scheduled for 7 Sept), removal of mould and sanding and painting of presbytery window sills (scheduled for 2024), doors and door frames, repairs to corroded church/school gutters (repairs scheduled for Sept school holidays), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark (on hold), painting of presbytery gutters and eaves (on hold), polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), clean second half of OSHC verandah wall and paint.

<u>POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING</u> – rreplace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), plaster repairs to ceilings in presbytery.

ecumenical Season of Creation, inspired by the words of the prophet Amos: "Let justice flow on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream" (5:24).

The evocative image used by Amos speaks to us of what God desires. God wants justice to reign; it is as essential to our life as God's children made in his likeness as water is essential for our physical survival. This justice must flow forth where it is needed, neither remaining hidden deep beneath the ground nor vanishing like water that evaporates before it can bring sustenance.
