GOSPEL REFLECTION

" Everybody's a Winner"

A parish in which I once served holds an annual egg hunt on Easter morning in the park behind the church. It is a delight to watch hundreds of toddlers filling their baskets with plastic eggs, each with a lolly inside. It used to be that a dozen of the eggs had a number inside of them corresponding to a giant Easter basket that a dozen children would be lucky enough to win. And that was the problem, because hundreds of children lost, and most of them cried. It got so competitive that parents were seen the day before, Holy Saturday, practicing with their children so they could gather as many eggs as possible and raise the odds of winning. So, the decision was made to remove the competition. Now it is just lollies in every egg. Every child wins. Everyone is happy.

Salvation is given to us today by God who loves us unconditionally. We did not win it. We did not earn it. It is not a prize for some but a gift for all given through the death and Resurrection of Jesus. Knowing that Jesus is alive in our midst should bring us great joy, a joy to be shared knowing that the same gift is offered to all around us today, to people everywhere. Our search for that joy is over. Today "Alleluia" comes forth from all of us, from those baptised at the Vigil to lifelong believers.



RECENT ACTIVITIES – installed security screens and roller blinds on OSHC building extension.

CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE - repairs to Church Men's toilet (leaking), repairs to corroded church/school gutters (quote pending), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark, painting of presbytery gutters and eaves, removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), polishing vinyl flooring in church, implement repairs to stop water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets), renewal of Termite Management system around the church building (quote obtained).

POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING - replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace/repair rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.
