GOSPEL REFLECTION

"NEW IDEAS FOR HALLOWEEN"

As usual, the gospel is peopled with more characters than other readings, giving us lots to think about for masquerade purposes. You get a second chance to consider Jesus – though he is the historical person and not the post-resurrection "Christ" that Paul references in his letter. Would there be a difference between the two costumes of Jesus Christ, in your design? And how about "the Son of Man," a particular title for Jesus, the meaning of which even scholars are divided about? If you had three people in costumes as Jesus – the Christ, the man, and the Son of Man – how would you distinguish them, if at all?

If that's too much theology to handle at a Halloween party, you might take the easy way out and comes as Zacchaeus. (Note: Only short people could consider Zacchaeus, since that's his outstanding characteristic.) Nature lovers might take a shot at portraying the sycamore tree. Endless possibilities!

How many titles of Jesus can you name, and what does each reveal about who he is?

Okay, most people will not have a Halloween party on biblical themes. But using religious imagination to reflect on Scripture is a time-honoured tradition. Each Sunday, identify with a member of the biblical cast. Consider what you learn through this identification.

Envelopes to request Masses to be offered for the sick, dying, deceased or for special intentions are available at the back of the church.

Mass Cards are available from the Piety Stall.

From 14 October 2022, it will no longer be mandatory to self-isolate at home if you test positive to COVID-19, however, Queensland Health strongly recommends people who are sick with symptoms of acute respiratory infection or who have tested positive to COVID-19: stay home to isolate until your symptoms resolve symptoms include new or worsening respiratory indicators including cough, breathing difficulty, sore throat or runny nose/nasal congestion. Other symptoms may include headache, muscle aches, fatique, nausea or vomiting, fever and diarrhoea. You should get tested for COVID-19 if you have symptoms of an acute respiratory infection and report a positive Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) result to Queensland Health. With regards to our clergy and employees: those who are COVID positive and symptomatic should not attend work for at least 7 days since they received a positive COVID-19 test result. They must also wait until any acute respiratory symptoms such as cough, breathing difficulty, sore throat, fever or runny nose/nasal congestion have resolved. They can return if they are only experiencing residual symptoms such as a mild dry cough. asymptomatic employees must wear a N95 mask for 7 days and follow hygiene requirements if they attend work. These masks can be purchased at a local chemist.

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

RECENT ACTIVITIES: no activities.

CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE: — annual gutter cleaning of parish and OSHC buildings (9 Nov), cleaning of carpets in Parish Office & OSHC (10 Nov), clean and paint presbytery walls on shady side of building, obtain quotes for removal of trees alongside boundary fence beside presbytery (roots in drains), high-pressure water-blast pathway leading to church, polishing vinyl flooring in church, investigate evidence of water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets, ceiling in chapel above central window), obtain quote for Termite management system renewal around the church building.

POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING: replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.
