GOSPEL REFLECTION

"WHATS YOUR PLAN?"

We are a society of planners. We've got calendars scrawled black and blue with appointments; smartphones in our pockets; magnets holding up lists all over the fridge. Our budgets tell us where the money's gone to, and copious records are filed for the tax agent. I can tell you where I'm going to be and what I'll be doing on most days a year from now! This can be a little intense.

Jesus has no dispute with careful schedules and records. But he wonders aloud that we take such care to plan dental appointments six months ahead and show far less concern for responsibilities of discipleship. Which will last longer: our teeth or our souls? We know where our money's invested and how much our next pay-packet will bring in, but what spiritual riches have we stored for ourselves? I know where I'll be on Sunday a year from now. But where will I be when God's kingdom comes?

How would you go about planning a spiritual budget for a year? For today? Add these items to your spiritual budget: Weekly Eucharist. Regular personal prayer. Time with Scripture. Seasonal self-examination and reconciliation. Annual retreat time. A spiritual audit of what you do with your time and money.

"Simply put, if you're not willing to take what is dearest to you, whether plans or people, and kiss it goodbye, you can't be my disciple".



Dear Bishop, Father, Descon,

Launch of the Archdiocese of Brisbane Refuger Sponsorship Initiative

This September the Archdiocese will launch a new initiative to support individuals and families who are refugees. Your parish is invited to cossider joining this effort.

The Church has roots in the story of a family seeking refuge. Joseph, Mary and Jesus fled Bethlehens when King Herod began to stalk the baby born as Christ the King (Man 2: 1-23). The Huly Family took what they had and sought safety in a place far from Herod's numberous sway. They fled not because they warned to but because it was a matter of life and death for the child.

There are many families around the world who face this same dreadful choice. They have everything they know, own and love for an unknown place, in the hope of a still unknown safety. People are making each choices every day. There are couples who have met, married, given birth and raised children in refugee camps, with no certainty about their future or where they might find a home.

Like us, they are created in the image of God. They are no different in dignity and ability; but they are the victims of circumstances beyond their control. That is why the Church is dutybound to offer them the welcome of Chirk.

The Archdiocese is partnering with Community Refugee Sponsorship Australia in order to liminch the Archdiocese of Brishane Refugee Sponsorship Initiative. Community Refugee. Sponsorship Australia is a well ostablished and registered charity which works to support community groups in raising funds and offering welcome to people seeking to make a home in Australia.

For these perishes and school which choose to participene, Community Refugee Sponsorship Australia will partner with them to raise funds and to support and build relationships with people as they settle into their new home here.

It is an opportunity for us to reach out beyond the bounds of our own community in a spirit of mission. This will in turn make our own communities strenger, for we will be strengthered only if we turn outworks nather than inwards. Therefore, I ask that your porish or community consider being part of this initiative.

The Inclusion Team of Evangelisation Brishane has carriage of this and would be happy to provide mere information on how to take port in the Archdiocese of Brishane Refugee Spensorship Initiative. May the God who has welcomed us and who calls us all home inspire us to share the gift we have received and to receive the gift of new sisters and brothers.



Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

RECENT ACTIVITIES: installed in-ground drains between presbytery and parish office, installed framed Emergency Exit signs in OSHC building.

CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE: complete high-pressure water-blasting of pathways around Presbytery, high-pressure water-blast pathway leading to church, fix four downlights in chapel, paint altar alcove wall, cleaning of carpets in Parish Office, polishing vinyl flooring in church, replace two remaining fluros in OSHC building, investigate evidence of water leaks (wall in priest sacristy, ceiling above reconciliation facility, gutter outside toilets, ceiling in chapel above central window), obtain quote for Termite management system renewal around the church building.

POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING: replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), repaint inside walls of presbytery, replace rusted-out gutter at chapel end of church building.
