"Tough Compassion"

If someone was locked in the embrace of sin, it's the servant in this parable about mercy. Though compassion is shown to him, he's incapable of returning it. Watch the way he treats his fellow servant! His unforgiveness imprisons him in the same way.

The spirit of unforgiveness lurks in Peter's question about 'how much' forgiveness is required. What he's really asking is: When can I reasonably refuse to forgive those who offend me? Surely there's a limit to how much forgiveness is strictly necessary.

Jesus won't play this game. Jesus paints God as a king willing to forgive an outrageous sum owed to him, not because it's necessary - a king has no obligation to forgive anything - but for compassion's sake. Peter, in the guise of the first servant, sees his anger against his brother as actually justifiable. In the world of gospel parable, that attitude is destined for destruction. Holding others bound to their sin poisons our love. Our unforgiveness reveals how far short we fall of the mercy God shows to us. When I'm in opposition to a sister or brother, I know it's for my sake, as much as for theirs, that I find my way to forgiveness.

To the extent that I choke my neighbour with my wrath, that's how far the embrace of sin has choked the love out of me.

Workplace Health and Safety, Maintenance and Improvements:

<u>RECENT ACTIVITIES</u> – re-gassed Air Conditioner in OSHC new section (warranty repair), put sliding door in OSHC back on rollers, glued down lifted vinyl flooring plank in OSHC.

<u>CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE</u> – install additional power point in OSHC, install timers on light poles in school/parish carpark, removal of mould and sanding and painting of presbytery window sills (scheduled for 2024), doors and door frames, repairs to corroded church/school gutters (repairs scheduled for Sept school holidays, hopefully), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark (on hold), painting of presbytery gutters and eaves (on hold), polishing vinyl flooring in church, clean second half of OSHC verandah wall and paint.

<u>POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING</u> – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval), plaster repairs to ceilings in presbytery.
