THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT December 14th 2025 Year A

Look Again:

Finding the Quiet Signs of Christ in an Unexpected World

(Matthew 11: 2 - 11)



Jesus told them, "Go back and tell John what's going on: The blind see, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the wretched of the earth learn that God is on their side. Is this what you were expecting? Then count yourselves most blessed!" (Matthew 11: 4-6)

John the Baptist, once so sure of who Jesus was, now sits in prison and sends a question that feels surprisingly familiar: "Are you the one who is to come?" Advent meets us right here – in the tension between faith and uncertainty. It reminds us that even the strongest disciples can have moments of doubt, and that bringing our questions to Jesus is itself an act of trust.

Jesus doesn't answer John with theories or slogans. He simply points to what is happening: the blind see, the lame walk, the poor hear good news. In other words, look at the signs of life emerging in unexpected places. Look at the quiet ways God is already at work

For families and parish communities, this is a gentle challenge. In a season filled with noise, pressure, and busyness, can we notice where grace is breaking through? Perhaps in a small act of kindness, a moment of reconciliation, a child's curiosity about the Advent candles, or the parish reaching out to someone who feels forgotten. These might not seem dramatic, but they are signs of the same kingdom Jesus spoke of.

Jesus also praises John's role, yet says the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. This isn't to diminish John but to remind us that in Christ we share something extraordinary. We are invited not just to watch for God's work but to participate in it, to carry hope, mercy, and justice into our homes and neighbourhoods.

On this Third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, we are invited to rejoice – not because everything is perfect, but because Christ is near and already shaping our world in ways we sometimes overlook. May our families and parishes become places where others can see the quiet signs of God's presence and discover for themselves that Jesus truly is the One who comes.

The Second Rite of Reconciliation

(Penance or Confession)

The Second Rite of Reconciliation is a communal reconciliation which celebrates God's love and mercy. It is often celebrated in parish communities during Advent and Lent.

The Second Rite of Reconciliation begins with a hymn, celebration of the Word – scripture and prayer - then a personal examination of conscience. This is followed by a one-to-one brief interaction with the priest as sins are confessed and absolved. (There will be extra priests available so that the sacrament does not take too long.)

The Rite concludes with a short thanksgiving, blessing and sending forth to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ. You are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity as part of your Christmas preparation, if you possibly can.
