Second Sunday in Ordinary Time -

Mission and Baptism

The Second Sunday readings connect to the Baptism of the Lord, emphasizing that baptism calls us to mission.

In John's Gospel, John the Baptist identifies Jesus as "the lamb of God"—the ultimate sacrifice who gave everything to restore humanity's relationship with God. Jesus is both the lamb offered to God by humanity and God's gift to us, which is why we repeat "Behold the lamb of God" during the Eucharist.

The first reading from Isaiah presents the Suffering Servant, called not only to restore Israel but to be "a light to the nations"—bringing salvation to all people, including non-Jews. Jewish tradition interprets this corporately: through baptism, we join this mission to be servants of the Lord and light to the world.

Our response, like the psalm says, should be "Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will." God doesn't want more sacrifice—Jesus was sufficient. God wants our availability and willingness to announce justice.

Paul's letter to Corinth reminds us that, like Paul, we're called to bring good news to those we meet. The conclusion: God has believed in us from the womb, entrusting us to be light to the world, nourishing us with Christ's sacrifice so we can serve others.

To be baptized is to be a person on a mission.
